

**PRELIMINARY REPORT OF SALMON ENHANCEMENT PRODUCTION IN JAPAN  
[1992]**

Fisheries Agency of Japan

Total juvenile salmon released from hatcheries stood at about 2.2 billion, but remained at about the 1983 level in 1992 (Table 1). Chum salmon releases in 1992 were approximately 93%, and pink salmon were approximately 6% of the total releases. The remaining releases were masu and sockeye salmon. In 1992, adult salmon captured for the enhancement program totalled about 3.7 million, of which approximately 73% were chum salmon, and 26% were pink salmon (Table 2).
